- (3.8) 2 preventive medical campaigns** in the province of Pisco in alliance with the NGO Vida Perú

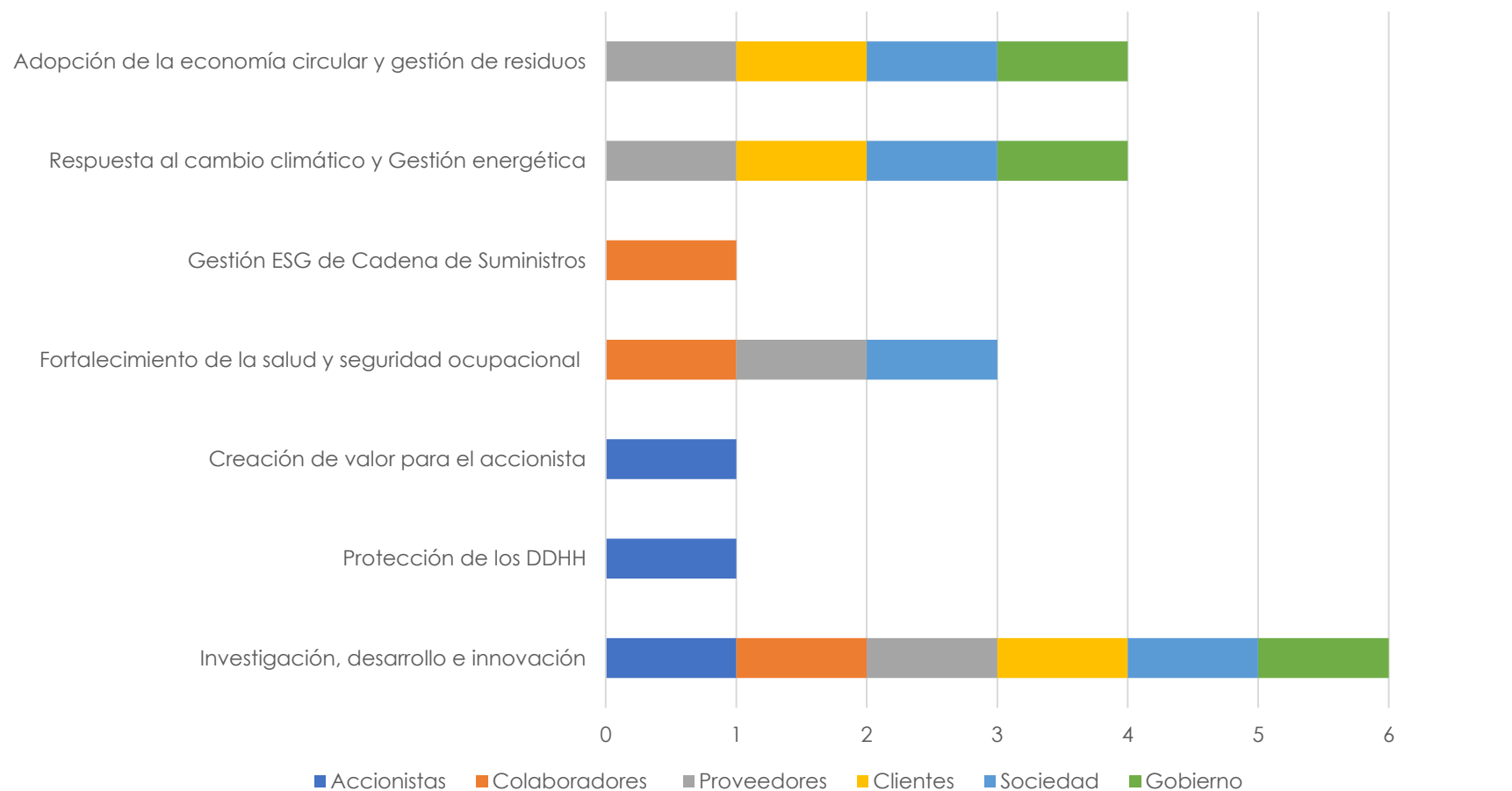
